## Gateway to World Service SU supports the mission

Simpson University is dedicated to the mission of changing lives across the globe. To accomplish that task we want to impact the lives of our own Christian & Missionary Alliance (C&MA) family. This ideal has inspired Simpson University to create The Legacy Alliance Scholarship Program to support our church families in making a four-year private Christian education a reality while still serving the world for Christ.

### Scholarship Program

Our desire is to make attending Simpson University an affordable option for as many C&MA families as possible.

#### Who is eligible to apply for the scholarship?

Any interested student must request an endorsement letter from their C&MA pastor or youth pastor that will be attached to The Legacy Alliance Scholarship and Sponsor application.

#### How much is the scholarship?

The Legacy Alliance Scholarship will be an award **up to \$15,000**. A student can also receive **up to \$3,000** with the Simpson University Matching Award when a family member, business, or church sponsor commits to providing funds toward the student's education at Simpson University. Therefore a student can receive **up to \$18,000 (up to \$72,000 over four years)** from Simpson University through The Alliance Legacy Scholarship program.

#### Scholarship benefits

The Legacy Alliance Scholarship pays a majority of a student's tuition and allows a student to maximize their federal student aid to pay for the remaining portion of tuition and residential housing.

#### Additional Requirements

Recipients of the scholarship must commit to living on campus to experience the benefits of the Simpson University community unless approved to live off campus.

### HOW TO GET THE LEGACY ALLIANCE SCHOLARSHIP

#### STEP 1

Apply to Simpson University at [simpsonu.edu/apply](http://simpsonu.edu/apply) for the fall or spring semester. During the university application process you will be asked to write a short-answer question regarding your faith journey.

#### STEP 2

Submit your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at [fafsa.ed.gov](http://fafsa.ed.gov). Remember to add Simpson University school code 001291 to your FAFSA application.

#### STEP 3

Submit **The Legacy Alliance Scholarship and Sponsor Application** to Student Financial Services no later than May 1.

#### STEP 4

Submit your intent to enroll and deposit to Simpson University.

## STAYING COMMITTED

John Stumbo began the Friday morning service by reminding us that through the thunderous roar of our inner and outer lives, the mighty voice of God can still be heard; that "His whisper can be louder than all the noise of the world once it penetrates the soul"—and that He remains enthroned as our Mighty King forever. It's the covenant—the *commitment*—He's made to His people.

John then reaffirmed his four commitments to the Alliance family "for this moment in our journey together":

**1. I will continue to listen**—not only to our speaking Lord but also to our speaking family. Operating under the leadership philosophy that "a desk is a poor place from which to lead a denomination," John remains committed to being out among the churches and listening to those he's been entrusted to lead.

**2. I will continue to be transparent.** "I try not to live with

any secrets," John notes, while acknowledging that restraint is a necessary leadership quality that must be exercised when determining the right time to present an idea or address an important issue.

**3. I will continue to make mistakes**—acknowledging that interacting with those who are different than we are can get clunky at times; but "It's better to be clumsy in a cross-cultural situation than to be smug in isolation."

**4. I will continue to challenge you**—"I've got my hiking boots, and I'm heading inland. The highlands of Galatia await. It's a trek, and I'm not traveling alone, because I'm not going for speed—I'm going for distance . . . and I'm inviting you to journey with me."

We have heard the heart of our leader. May we now exercise courage in our 1 Corinthians commitment to follow his example, as he follows the example of Christ.


